Dear Parents and Carers,



We have had an exciting time in our science topics so far, which the children have enjoyed. To consolidate the learning, Year 4 have organised a day for the children to fully discover a world of science at Thinktank Birmingham. On **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023**, we be visiting Thinktank. The day will include a tour of Thinktank and an 'Electrify Science' workshop, where the children will have fun learning and replicating scientific discoveries from Ancient Greece to the modern day. They will also make a larger than life human circuit and finish by looking at the dangers of electricity and how a little electrical understanding can keep us all safe.

In order to arrive at Thinktank at 10:00am, the children will need to be in school for **8:30am**. The coach will be leaving school at 8:50am. We will be leaving Thinktank at 2:30pm, hoping to arrive back at school at approximately **3:00pm**.

Children must bring a packed lunch unless they are entitled to a free school meal. Children who are entitled to a free school meal will receive a text asking if you want school to provide a packed lunch for the trip, please reply YES or No to the text no later than Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March to order one. All children must bring a drink. There is an area at the location for bags to be kept during the day's activities.

The cost of the trip is £17.50, which includes cost of entry to Thinktank, access to the activities, workshop and coach transport to and from Thinktank. The payment for this visit should be made via Parent pay. Please pay £5 deposit by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March and the balance of £12.50 by Monday 20<sup>th</sup> March.
