Year 6 Transition to Secondary School Parent Workshop

To Parents/Carers of Year 6 pupils

I am writing to you to invite you to attend a parent workshop called 'Supporting your child with transitions'.



The workshop will be delivered by Marisha Samuda, the named Educational Mental Health Practitioner for Burnt Tree Primary, as part of the Reflexions programme. It will focus on supporting children through the transition from Year 6 to Secondary school.

During this workshop, Marisha will meet the following aims:

- To understand the different feelings associated with transition
- To learn strategies for how to support your child to manage their anxiety
- To understand who you can speak to and where to go if you or your child is feeling anxious
