Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to announce that we will be **trialing a new approach** to PE lessons based on feedback from parents, pupils and teachers. To maximise the time spent in physical activity, we will be allowing children to come to school dressed in their **PE kits on the days they have PE** starting when we return to school on Monday 24th February.

However, as we take great pride in our school's smart appearance, children must wear the correct **school-approved PE kit** only.

This consists of:

- **Plain white T-shirt**
- **Black PE shorts (no cycling shorts)**
- **Black jogging bottoms/leggings (optional, for colder weather)**
- **Black hoodie or school jumper (optional, for colder weather)**
- **No logos or any other colours are allowed**



Children should continue to **wear their school shoes** to and from school but must have **suitable PE pumps/trainers** in school to change into for their PE lesson.

As this is a trial, we will be closely monitoring its impact. If we find that it is not beneficial, or if children are **not adhering to the correct PE kit**, we will return to children changing in school as before.

If your child **does not have the correct PE kit**, they should attend school in their **usual school uniform** and will be allowed to change at school for their PE lesson.

We appreciate your support in ensuring that this trial runs smoothly and look forward to seeing the positive impact it may have on our PE lessons. We will confirm after the Easter holidays in April whether this trial will continue long term.
