Welcome back to school after the six weeks holiday! We hope that you have had lots of fun and are ready to work hard at school again!

We will soon be starting work on our exciting new topic of The Great Fire of London!

We thank all of the parents and carers who have sent their children to school with book bags and PE kits. PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday. Please ensure that your child has a PE kit in school on these days which contains shorts, a t-shirt and a pair of pumps. Please also ensure that your child does **not wear earrings** on PE days. Many thanks for your co-operation with this.

Homework

Your child will be given a 'learning log' to take home and complete homework in. At the front of the learning log is a grid that lists homework tasks that your child can complete related to their topic. Learning log homework needs to be completed weekly. Children will also be given spelling homework every week and will be tested on these words. Your child will be able to access games to accompany the word lists on Spelling Shed which can be found online using their Wonde password (please ask the class teacher if you do not have the log in details for this). Spelling tests will take place every Wednesday.

Money and snacks

Please send toast money, £1 for the week with your child. If you need to make any payments on any other days please visit the school office where the staff will be pleased to help you. If your child does not have a piece of toast, they will be given a variety of fruits to choose from. Please also make sure your child has their own water bottle in school for them to refill during the day.

Reading and Writing

It is essential that your child reads at least three times a week at home with an adult. Your child will come home with two reading books, one that links specifically to their phonics/guided reading sessions and the other a levelled home reader book. **It is very important that your child brings these books to school every day so that staff can also hear them read.** Reading books will be changed every Friday. Your child needs a suitable book bag or packet (not a rucksack) in order to keep their reading books and learning log safe. These books must be looked after and brought back to school so that your child can change their reading books and hand in homework. Book bags are available to buy from the school office. Please note that if reading books are lost there will be a small charge to replace them.

PSHE

This term our PSHE units are called 'Being me in my world' and 'Celebrating differences'. In these topics we will be discussing how families are different and appreciating that differences are good and they make us all unique. Children will learn to respect differences and understand that the way they live their lives might be different from how their friends live theirs.
