### **PUNCTUALITY** The school day starts at 8.45am.

Every day pupils are arriving late through the main office. This impacts their education as they are missing vital learning time in the morning every time they are late and disrupts the rest of the class. Please help to reduce late arrivals by:

- Establishing a good routine in the mornings and evenings so your child is prepared for the school day ahead.
- Ensure your child leaves home early enough to arrive at school on time for 8.45am.

#### **ILLNESS**

Any absence due to illness must be notified to the school office on the first day of absence as early as possible as per school policy. Please ensure you either telephone the office on 0121 557 2967 or reply to absence text messages stating the reason for the absence. However, children can attend school with minor illnesses and are always welcome to join us if they feel better later on during the day, rather than missing a whole day of learning. Please read NHS guidance by following this link 'Is my child too ill for school?'

#### **MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS**

Routine doctor, dentist and optician appointments should always be made outside of the school day if possible to minimise impact on attendance and learning. We appreciate that hospital appointments are out of your control. Please provide written evidence of hospital appointments as this will be recorded and considered when calculating if a pupil will be eligible to receive an attendance award.

### **RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE**

School can authorise 1 day of absence for religious observance on 2 separate occasions during an academic year (Not 2 days of absence for one religious' event). Again, this will be considered when calculating pupil eligibility for attendance awards.

#### LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Government guidance states that leave of absence should not be taken during term time. So far this academic year <u>42</u> pupils have taken leave of absence meaning they have missed valuable learning time in school. Referrals are being made to Sandwell School Attendance Service for issue of Penalty Notices (fines) as per school policy. Please demonstrate your commitment to your child's education by not taking leave of absence during term time.

Any leave of absence must be applied for on the official form at least 3 weeks prior to commencement of the leave.

#### **ATTENDANCE AWARDS**

We have weekly, termly and annual Attendance Awards available for the children to earn by attending school every day.
